- Demonstrate professional, ethical behavior, including boundaries with clients.
- Close Communication with Supervisor is imperative to ensure house/shift coverage.
- Provide verbal and written communication with other staff as needed.
- Answer phones & door as needed.
- Be available to respond to Security Monitoring Company when necessary.
- Be available to clients at all times.
- Intervene in emotional emergency- refer to case manager for ongoing counseling.
- Record information for staff in appropriate logs.
- Attend all required monthly RCS meetings, events, and trainings.

- Computer skills.
- CPR & First Aid Certification.

- Ability to relate to individuals from all socio-economic levels of life.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
